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CONTINUING EDUCATION

Certified Professionals in Management of Invasive Plants will be required to meet the minimum continuing education requirements of 30 hours during the 3-year certification period in order to renew their certification. Courses or training sessions and the number of hours counting toward re-certification will be approved by the NAWMA Certification Committee or a state or provincial agency or association authorized by the Committee. Some credits should be earned in each year of the three-year certification period. Continuing Education Units (CEUs) may be earned by attending approved training sessions or other approved means:

1. 10 hours for attending a NAWMA Annual Conference and Trade Show.
2. Training sessions for weed managers sponsored by state/provincial weed management agency or association.
 1. Submit an approval request form with an agenda if available. If not, planned topics, dates, location and hours of training. (Not eligible if also used for meeting certified pesticide applicator requirements.)
2. Other approved credits
 - a. Other training sessions submitted and approved.
 - b. Leadership credits – up to 5 credits per year for serving as an officer or standing committee chairman of state/provincial weed management associations or a NAWMA board member.
 - c. Self-study – up to 5 credits per year for approved self-study.

Reporting Continuing Education Credits Earned

1. Use [Self-Reporting Form](#) to report attendance at approved training sessions, leadership credits and self study.
2. The [Continuing Education Workshop Roster](#) to report the attendance of several participants at an approved training sessions.
3. Use [Continuing Education Request for Approval of Training Session Form](#) for approval of new or previously taken training sessions that have not been approved. Once approved, the Self-Reporting Form may be submitted.
